

Lakewood Arts Council's Adopt -a-School Program – October, 2023



JeffCo Remote Learning Program (JRLP) is another “first” for Lakewood Arts.

JRLP is a completely online K-12 school in Jefferson County.

Art teachers Tiffani Breslain and Julie Naegel contacted LAC for assistance with art technique instruction in a format adaptable for their 100% remote classes.

We decided to provide virtual instruction in “Basic Face Drawing” at a weekly Art Club session. Co-op artist Robyn Cochran-Ragland created an instructional video and provided teaching aids for student practice in art classes.

These occurred prior to her online presentation as a “guest teacher” in October. The middle and high school students who attended thoroughly enjoyed the program. Thanks to Robyn for everything she did to help make this program happen!

In order to provide the students with the opportunity to show their artwork outside of their school website, the teachers provided links for online access (see below). We are currently exploring future classes and hope to have their students exhibit at the gallery in the future.
